

Soyuz with the famous moored to the space station

Russian Soyuz ship on which he flew into space aboard the famous circus founder Guy Laliberté sun, now moored to the International Space Station (ISS) - informed the Russian flight control center.

Along with "the first clown in space", hailed as a Canadian, flew to the ISS Soyuz Russian Maxim Surajew and American Jeffrey Williams.

Laliberte well adapted to the state of weightlessness, and the board held a small demonstration of soap bubbles - have informed Russian sources on Thursday. Astronauts will spend six months on the ISS, which is the seventh in a row space tourist, will remain on the eight days.
